We will be making brief contacts on many frequencies and modes, exchanging signal reports and basic weather data exchange (sunny, rain, temperature, etc.) with any station in any location. WX4NHC will be on the air on HF, VHF, UHF, 2 & 30 meter APRS and WinLink wx4nhc@winlink.org subject must contain //WL2K.

We will try to stay on the Hurricane Watch Net frequency 14.325 MHz most of the time. Also 7.268 MHz depending on propagation. However, we will be operating different frequencies depending on QRM. How to fill out the Field Situation Report:

- Open Winlink Express (insure you have a most recent version, ie. 1.6.4 or higher, Template Version 1.0.193.0 or higher.)
- Open "New Message" form. (First ICON in menu).
- On New Message Form, look for "Select Template" menu.
- Choose "Select Template."
- 4. Double click on "Standard Templates"
- 5. Choose "Mapping GIS Forms."
- 6. Choose "Field Situation Report.txt"
- 7. Your browser should open with the HTML Form.
